Meeting called to order at 1:30 p.m. at the Shoshone-Bannock Hotel and Casino

## **2014 Conference Report:**

- Conference packets with conference registration forms and vendor application forms were handed out to each board member.
  - Richelle will add conference contact information to the registration form.
- At conference registration, each attendee will receive a conference packet with casino dollars to use at the casino.
- An e-mail blast will be going out to all R.T.'s in Idaho, Montana, Wyoming and Utah about the ISRT conference.
- Mike Latimer was recommended to be the ASRT representative at the conference.
- More vendors are needed. So far there are only 2 vendors sponsoring the conference; Medical Imaging and Turn Key Medical.
- \$600.00 will be needed for door prizes and conference packets.
- On average 125 R.T.s attend the conference.
- Average cost of ISRT conferences is \$12,000 - \$17,000.
- Motion made, seconded and passed to add a Friday night session for 1 CE.
  - Suggested topics for night session are a licensure forum, a motivational speaker, or an open discussion on ISRT opportunities.
  - Appetizers would be served.

### **President Report- Candice Moore**

- ASRT reviewed ISRT's by laws. The by laws will be sent to all ISRT members 60 days before the ISRT conference. At the conference, members will vote on the by laws.
- The affiliate due date is the last day of January. The board needs to decide who the alternates will be. The ASRT meeting is June 26-29, 2014.
- ISRT fiscal year is June 1st – May 31st. Compliance forms are due August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ISRT is in good standing with the IRS and has a Secretary of State certificate.

### **Licensure Chairman Mike Gurr-**

- Licensure update
  - ISU will do a media event before the January legislative session starts.
  - The Legislative session goes from January to March.
  - Techs will be at the capitol when the new legislative session begins in January.
    - Display student exhibits at the capitol.
  - Mike is working with five lobbyists including, IMA, IHA and the chiropractors.
- Motion for all ISRT members to be on the licensure committee was seconded and passed unanimously.
- Motion for a board & licensure committee conference call to go through the bill line by line was seconded and passed unanimously.
- As a board and licensure committee, we need to be able to factually dispute misperceptions of the bill.
  - Example: R.T. licensure will cost the state of Idaho a lot of money.
  - Truth: R.T. licensure will be managed by the Bureau of Occupational professions with minimal costs.
- Hospital Administrators need to have the bill explained to them.
- Respond to Representative Fred Wood's letter.
  - Identify and work to resolve items of concern listed.

### **President Elect- Gerald Beckler**

- Recommended that the board meet more than 4 times a year.

- Improve communications by sending and replying to all board members on all e-mails.
- Suggested all board members be a part of the licensure bill.
- Recommended that everyone read and make notes on the licensure bill before the next licensure meeting.
  - The licensure committee will be meeting in a couple weeks.
  - Make sure notes are taken at the licensure committee meeting.

**Secretary- Lacy Patterson**

- Rad Tech Week
  - Mike Gurr will get a “proclamation” from the governor.
  - The board will meet and provide lunch with BSU, ISU, CSI, Lewis & Clark, and Northern Idaho schools.
    - Inform students about the “Student Development Program”.
    - Ask students to exhibit research at the capitol in January.
    - Goal: to build a repore with the students and maintain a good relationship with the professors.
    - Goal: to increase ISRT membership.
  - Utilize Rad tech week to reach out and correspond with hospital techs.
    - An ISRT packet will be mailed or delivered to 34 hospitals in Idaho.
      - The packet will include: conference registration forms, ISRT membership applications, a copy of the licensure bill and candy.
    - Goal: Increase conference attendance, increase ISRT membership, increase licensure support.
  - Wendy will contact ASRT for funds with this membership and licensure drive.
