## **ISRT Post-Conference Board Meeting April 16, 2011**

Meeting called to order at 7:04pm MST

**Conference Report:** It looks like there will be approximately \$8000 made. There were approximately 140 attendees. We will be combining with Washington for next year's Conference. This will take place in Spokane.

**Presidents Report:** Discussed the plan for Licensure. Asked what it would take to hire a Lobbyist. We need to work out a plan and have a bill ready before we do any lobbying. We need to work on our public awareness campaign. We need to find a Legislator that will be influential in getting this passed. We need to present a bill that is solid. We need to show how it will save money, and be safer to have this bill. We need to capitalize on the media that is being released regarding radiation exposure. We can go to the ASRT and get a sample bill that we can tweak to meet Idaho's needs. Discussed hiring a PR Representative for ISRT. Social networking will be key in promoting awareness. A letter writing campaign would be easy to do on Facebook. The President will continue to communicate with the Board the progress of this plan.

**President-Elect Report:** Discussed how many technologists in Idaho are actually ISRT members. It is a small percentage of technologists that are members and a small percentage that attend the Conference. Discussed some ways to increase the membership. It was suggested offering all the Registered Technologists in Idaho a free membership for 2012. It was also suggested mailing a copy of Scattered Radiation with the membership forms to all the Technologists. It was moved, seconded and passed to offer to all the Technologists in the state a free membership for the 2012 membership fee, with the fee going back to \$25.00 in 2013. Also, dropping the \$5.00 late fee.

**Treasurer's Report:** Report will be emailed to the board.

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We need to find a Conference Chairman to work with Washington. We need to decide how the finances will work for this.

**Historian Report:** David is working on the book

**Scattered Radiation:** Nothing at this time.

**Old Business:** Discussed the bylaw change that was voted on at the Business Meeting. We may want to consider changing it again in the future so that the Board members are elected by the membership. Information on becoming a Board Member will be sent out in Scattered
