

## ISRT Meeting Minutes 1/24/23 1904 - 2002

Meeting minutes:

Per Tim, speakers for the upcoming virtual ISRT conference are beginning to line up.

Rendi has a potential MRI Technologist speaker from Oregon interested in providing a talk. This person will need an itinerary first to verify availability with schedules.

Tim offers to Rendi the option of speakers pre-recording their talks if easier.

Breezy asks if the Conference Committee should be looped in at this point. Consensus is to approach all resources if those people are willing to assist.

Per Tim, sponsors are needed also. The end of April will be the video conference. Target February 10<sup>th</sup> as the date to have Facebook postings and notice to academic program directors.

Tim has an oncology speaker possibly interested in speaking.

Rendi and Tim mention that all three speakers are close to being scheduled, however, none are current locks for speaking.

Mike asks Rendi if a North Canyon physician has given any indication of speaking commitments. Both Rendi and Mike will follow-up with this physician.

Tim has deposited one check for \$500 from a sponsor. Breezy confirms a check from IMI deposited Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup> for \$500.

Tim provides to Casey the typical sponsorship amounts: \$1000+ for Gold, \$500 - \$1000 Silver, & \$100 - \$500 Bronze. All amounts are accepted.

Tim confirms the ISRT webpage has option for sponsors to contribute by PayPal.

Casey has been working with a congresswoman. He is also interested in IHA providing feedback on the topic of state licensure. Casey offers the suggestion to write into any future legislation the option to

grandfather clause current personnel working in imaging roles. This is different from some of the prior attempts at writing licensure bills. Groups consensus if for Casey to proceed.

Casey asks and Tim confirms the fall conference will be virtual also.

Tim references charges for the last virtual conference. Stephanie charged in 2021 \$3 per virtual attendee, and \$15/hr. New pricing will need to be obtained before the \$35 fee charged to attendees is decided upon.

Tim mentions the availability of having more speakers during the fall conference due to the lack of a business meeting.

Casey and Tim discuss any requirements current travelers in the State may need to attend any virtual conference. All are welcome to sign-up.

Tim reaffirms action items for the group: All to follow-up on speaker commitments. The ISRT website needs an inspection to make sure it is up to date. Stephanie needs contacted about pricing. The hosting company needs contacted.

Rendi proposes Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> for the next ISRT meeting at 7pm. The group agrees. Tim will send out the invite to the group and will include the student leadership recipients.
