Meeting minutes:

Review of prior meeting minutes and action items conducted.

Candice was selected for an ASRT ultrasound term.

Speaker updates: Samantha Kilgallen is slated to record a speech. Ron Jones is slated to speak on Tech Burnout. Dr Geoffrey Thomas, Siemens, Bart Pierce, and Ike McDermott are scheduled to talk, and Casey Dye will give closing remarks.

Tim requests women's imaging speakers if any members have contacts.

Website updates: Conference links have been provided for webpage registration. Exhibit links have been added. A checkout code has been added on the webpage checkout to reduce the conference fee to free for appropriate members.

Breezy asks if memberships show expired despite being paid with checks if that presents a problem. Tim confirms the Paypal mechanism is preferred. Other methods of payment work but do not show immediate payment.

February Tim made contact with the website the ISRT has been working with. The company pitched more work to Tim, was turned down, and the company went silent a second time. The board will address next steps if the company remains silent this week.

Chris updates that Breezy will again offer to run for her current role. Other contacts have been reached out to and Chris is waiting for responses.

Jenny mentions that there is a Nate that has shown interest in President or possibly other ISRT roles.

Tim ideas that former students that have gone through student Leadership Program with the ASRT that have placed student applications with ISRT could be reached out to for possible ISRT roles.

Action Item: Tim will come up with a list of former students that ISRT can reach out to.

IMI will contribute \$500, Siemens will contribute \$1000 by means of their online grant website, and Madison Memorial will contribute \$1,000.

Casey asks if the President should have a welcome to the conference address regarding current jobs and state of the profession.

Action Item: Tim will take care of the agenda/script for the upcoming conference.

Tim asks about gift cards. Rendi confirms four \$25 amazon cards was previously agreed to.

Prizes for exhibits and essays are agreed to be the same as prior conferences.

A quiz bowl winner will win a \$1,000 scholarship in November. A quiz bowl will not be needed for the April event. Chris agrees to put this event together again.

An email blast for the April event is agreed to be a good plan. ISRT and ASRT email lists may be used to spread the word. A consolidated cohesive email list would be nice, however the webmaster gmail account is limited in its capabilities in sending to many recipients.

Candice has previous experience in sending out newsletters. She recommends sending it in smaller recipient lists in email host has restrictions.

Mike asks Casey what Madison Memorial requires for contributions to ISRT. Madison required a tax ID form and invoice both from the ISRT.

Financial updates: Breezy has monetary figures. The ISRT has checking funds of \$22,699.31, savings of \$13,858.40 and Paypal of \$2,623.98. Membership funds are trickling in slowly but not at expected rates.

Old business: Program director letters were complete. Vendor reminder letters have been sent.

New business: Nomination Committee was brought to this meeting as requested last meeting.

Casey brings up that the state of Tennessee is considering dropping imaging licensure. Casey wants to contact the ASRT about their stance on this State's bill. Mike mentions that New Hampshire has a similar bill.

Essay and poster submission volunteers is taken care of. Thank you to everyone who lined those volunteers out.
